Capt. Crunch Defense Fund Fails

John Thomas Draper, identified by the FBI as Captain Crunch, a legendary phone phreak — is broke and will be represented by the federal public defender.

Draper, 29, appeared before U.S. District Judge Robert Peckham in San Jose yesterday on telephone toll fraud charges. His attorney, John Thorne, said that a widely publicized underground Captain Crunch defense fund had thus far netted \$1.

And Draper said that his \$600 monthly income as consultant to a Palo Alto electronics firm will shortly be halved when he resumes his schooling.

Draper was arrested by the FBI last May, accused of non-paying manipulation of phone company electronic procedures to call several states and Australia.

Captain Crunch obtained his name from a toy whistle contained in cereal boxes that could be used to confuse phone company equipment.

Judge Peckham set trial for October 24.

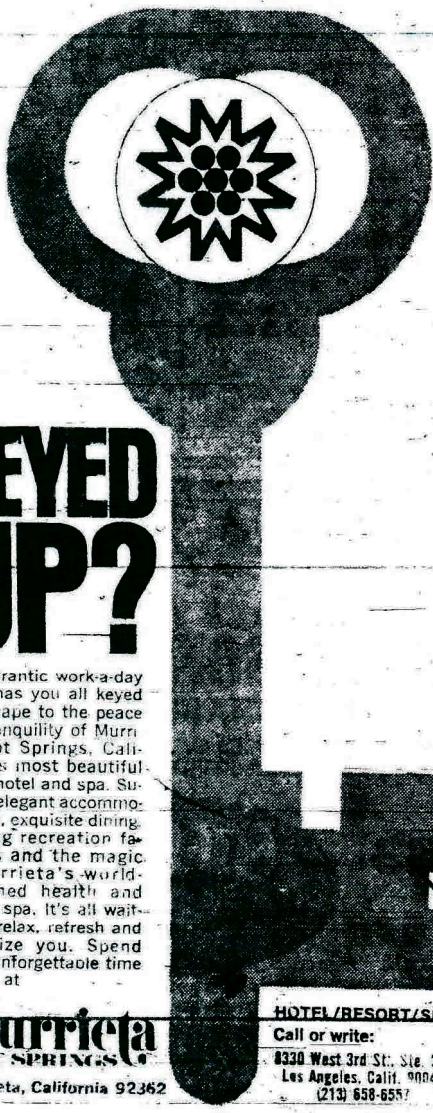
