Trial for Ike Turner

Rock musician Ike Turner of the group Ike and Tina Turner was ordered yesterday to stand trial on Aug. 6 in Inglewood, Calif., on charges of possessing "blue boxes." The illegal telephone device makes possible free long-distance calls by bypassing telephone company billing equipment. Turner and three co-defendants were arrested March 27 at an Inglewood recording studio on a warrant charging them with using telephones equipped with "blue boxes."
