FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: MARCH 15, 1976

FINANCIER BERNARD CORNFELD HAS BEEN NAMED AS A DEFENDANT IN A CIVIL LAWSUIT FILED IN SANTA MONICA SUPERIOR COURT BY PACIFIC TELEPHONE. THE COMPANY IS SEEKING OVER \$1 HILLION IN ACTUAL AND PUNITIVE DAMAGES FOR ALLEGED FRAUDULENT BLUE BOX USE.

A BLUE BOX IS AN ELECTRONIC DEVICE USED WITH A TELEPHONE TO AVOID INCURRING CHARGES FOR LONG DISTANCE CALLS.

ALSO NAMED A DEFENDANT IN THE SUIT IS GAYHALL, INC. OF WHICH CORNFELD IS PRESIDENT AND WHICH IS LOCATED IT HIS HOME IN BEVERLY HILLS.

TWO BLUE BOXES WERE SEIZED AT CORNFELD MANSION BY THE FBI ON JAN. 28, 1975. FOLLOWING THE SEIZURE, CORNFLD WAS INDICATED BY A FEDERAL COURT ON CRIMINAL CHARGES. HE WAS ELEASED ON \$10,000 BAIL AND ORDERED TO RETURN TO ENTER A PLEA ON THEE CHARGES TODAY.

PASSESSING OR USING A BLUE BOX IS A CRIE IN CALIFORNIA; USING A BLUE BOX IS A FEDERAL CRIME WHEN IT'S USE IN INTERSTATE OR FOREIGN COMMERCE.
