USE AND OPERATION OF RED BOX

Place speaker over the mouthpiece of the phone. Dial a 600 toll free number. When you hear the number start to ring press the STIZZ PUTTON (this is the SMALL RED button). This gives you an open longdistance line and puts the world at your fingertips. Next hit the RED KEY PULSE button (KP), this tells the computer you are ready to place a call. If you are calling anywhere in North America, then punch the area code, then the number you wish to call, next punch the GREEN STAR button (SF), this tells

the computer your "Dialing
is over and the phone
should ring on the other
end.

Overseas calls are a little
more difficult. You dial
the 800 number, STIZE it
when you make a connection
punch the KP and then
punch out the number for
an overseas sender (see
overseas sender numbers)
and finish by punching
the ST button. Wait for a
humming tone in the
receiver, you are now
ready to make an overseas
call. Punch the KP, then
either "0" for a satellite
or "1" for a cable con-
nection. Next punch the
County Code Number.

(see County Codes), then
the City Code Number
(see City Codes), next
punch the number you
wish to call, on complet-
ing these numbers press
the ST button and wait,
the ringing tone will
come after a series of
clicks (different countries
have different rings).

EXAMPLE: 800 number,
SIEZE, KP, 415-183, ST
(Oakland overseas sender).
KP, 1, 61, 72, 1194, ST
(Brisbane Australia Time)

If you do not get your call
completed try it again
(ITT is not perfect) or
try a different overseas
sender or lines (182,183,

186) or try Cable instead of Satalite.Do not use cable connection for Asia, Near & Far East.

Remember: All calls are prefaced by KP and ended with ST. Overseas sender used is your option as is Satalite or Cable connection. The more agile and fast you are with the key board the easier it will be to place calls. If a call does not go through, you do not have to hangup, just press the SWIZZ and start over, this can be done at anytime you make a mistake or are not connected with the number you have called. *NOTE: This instrument is
ILLEGAL. For greatest
safety in using, use as
many different 800 numbers
as possible. Do not make
calls too long. (If you
want to talk longer, call
back on a different 800
number). Do not talk about
the device over the phone.
