MEMPHIS (UPI) — U.S. Dist. Judge Robert McRae Jr. gave a former South Central Bell Telephone Co. employe a two-year prison sentence for cheating the company out of a long-distance toll of \$1.86.

Larry Owen Manning, 36, of Memphis, said he will appeal.

Manning was convicted of using a "blue box" to simulate telephone electronic signals, allowing him to avoid billing for a long-distance call.
