Toll Evasion Arraignment Continued

The arraignment of the Pasadena owner of an electronics firm and an employee charged with bypassing telephone toll charges was reset Friday for Dec. 23 at 9 a.m.

Judge David Williams of Department 100 of Los Angeles Superior Court granted the continuance for Louis G. MacKenzie, owner of MacKenzie Laboratories of 1455 Los Robles Ave. and Robert LaFond of Los Angeles.

The two were originally scheduled for arraignment Friday on one count of conspiracy and four counts of using electronics devices without authorization of Pacific Bell Telephone.

MacKenzie and LaFond allegedly used electronic devices that enabled them to make long distance phone calls without paying toll charges.
