Pair Seek Dismissal in Phone Case

A Los Angeles superior court judge Thursday took under submission a motion to dismiss charges against two men accused of manufacturing and selling an electronic device that allowed telephone users to make long distance calls without paying toll charges.

Judge Joseph A. Sprankle Jr. will rule on the motion Jan. 10, in the case against Louis G. MacKenzie, 41, of Pasadena, and Robert La Fond of Los Angeles.

Both were indicted on one count of conspiracy and four counts of using an electronic device without the authorization of the telephone company.

Charles E. Bitner, chief special agent for Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Co., said the pair manufactured and sold complicated electronic "tone generators" which deactivated the phone company's automatic billing mechanism, then completed long distance calls.
