Joe Engressia, USF student who achieved national fame for his ability to place long-distance telephone calls with his whistling talents will be on campus again this quarter.

His disciplinary hearing resulted in his disciplinary probation for Quarter II and a fine of \$25, a charity contribution, according to Dean Charles H. Wildy, dean of men.
